#### Arrr Dues

Your continued commitment and support are appreciated. When preparing the 2010 budget, our main goal was to maintain current membership prices. To achieve this, the board developed a Corporate Sponsorship Program. This sponsorship program along with anonymous member contributions will allow us to hold the line on dues. Thank you to all of you who paid your 2010 membership dues early and those who are taking advantage of the ACH withdrawal through Capitol Bank. This revenue keeps us afloat in the offseason.

### Save \$100 and maybe more

You may be able to save on the cost of your membership through your health insurance plan. Many insurance carriers offer cash back incentives for health-related expenses. For example, the Physician's Plus Healthy Choices and Dean Health Plan's WIN Program allow for reimbursements of \$100-\$300 for health and fitness memberships which include community pools such as ours. Essentially, a family can reduce its annual dues to \$425 with a \$300 reimbursement. Be sure to check your plan for any savings!

Encourage your friends and neighbors to join. New members that sign up by June 1, 2010 pay only \$100 (regularly \$422) for their initial membership fee. Increasing our membership is essential to our long-term success. The more, the merrier!

### VGBA Update, Spring Clean Up & Volunteering

Drain system improvements in both the baby and adult pools are necessary to comply with state and federal codes. Known as VGBA, this construction will begin in April 2010.

Please mark your calendar for **Spring Clean up dates: April 24, May 1 and May 8 from 9am-3pm** to help clean and paint *your* neighborhood pool. Due to the construction, we'll have a short time frame to complete these tasks before the 2010 Memorial Day Weekend opening.

The pool's success relies on the involvement of the members. We have always been very fortunate to have many enthusiastic volunteers supporting our club. As a reminder, all members are required to volunteer five hours. HPSC has many needs. The more you and your family can help, the less we have to pay outside vendors, which obviously helps in maintaining our dues.
